How did you hear about us?

- As the protection of personal data is very important to GIZ, we will describe in this document what kind of personal data is stored and for what it is used.
- Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH is responsible for data processing for as long as GIZ serves as the Secretariat of the Development and Climate Alliance. - Any personal data provided within the framework of the Development and Climate Alliance (last name, first name, headquarters/address, email address, telephone and mobile phone numbers, organisational affiliation, position, registrations, participations, photos), which are necessary for managing the interested parties and supporters of the Alliance, will be stored on servers within the European Economic Area and used for the purposes described below.
- The data will be used exclusively for the following purposes.
 - Contacting you and your organisation for sending information, requesting personal information and interests, invitations, registrations, notifications;
 - Registration of participants in events and use of personal data for registration and participation lists;
 - Transferring personal data within the group of supporters and the organisational circle for exchange and contact purposes;
 - Publishing the headquarters/address to identify the respective organisation on the stakeholders' map of the Alliance to be found on the website www.allianz-entwicklung-klima.de (however, no addresses of private individuals will be published).
- The legal basis for processing is currently the Statement of Commitment of the Development and Climate Alliance.
- The data will be used exclusively for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy; any other use will always be subject to renewed consent. Your data will not be used for advertising purposes.
- GIZ and any designated third parties (see below for further information) shall protect the data using suitable technical and organisational measures from falsification, destruction or loss (whether accidental or intentional) or access by unauthorised persons. Access to personal data will be restricted to those GIZ employees (Bonn site, unit G320, Development and Climate Alliance Support Programme) and any designated third parties who shall process this data in accordance with the aforementioned purpose(s) and who shall handle it properly and confidentially.
- The data will be shared exclusively with the third parties designated below. In case your data is shared with other third parties for the further fulfillment of the aforementioned purposes, your renewed consent is required.
 - Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) as a member of the Alliance's organisational circle
 - The Research Institute for Applied Knowledge Processing (FAW/n) as a member of the Alliance's organizational circle

Rights of data subjects

- You have the right to ask for your personal data, to have them rectified, if necessary, or to request the restriction of processing or the deletion of your data. In this case, your data will be deleted. You may also revoke your consent to the use of your personal data at any time. The revocation of consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing up to the moment of revocation.
